Stand on the edge of Ireland's most dramatic coastal cliffs with views that stretch across the Atlantic.




## Explore Edinburgh Castle

Relax on a scenic boat ride in England's Lake District, surrounded by hills, forests, and lakeside villages.




## Visit Cardiff Castle
